General Criteria

Work must be by architects/firms who are members of the AIA Flint Chapter

If multi-office firm, work by office in the AIA Flint Chapter

Shall be completed projects

Work completed in the last 10 years

All submissions will be displayed at ArtWalk and on AIA Flint Website

Registration entry fee to be \$200 per submission, no limit on submissions. Each category can be submitted as a "non-juried" submission; however, the entry fee must still be paid

Plaque will be awarded to winning entries, certificate for honorable mentions

Submission format

The format shall be provided as a PowerPoint slide presentation. Additional submission information will be provided via email once entry form is received.
